



Handicare Handwash

Composition	Aqua, Sodium Laureth Sulphate, Cocamidopropyl Betaine, Lauramine Oxide, Glycerin, Propylene Glycol, Sodium Chloride, Cocamido DEA, Potassium Sorbate, Fragrance, Citric Acid, Caprylyl Glycol and Phenoxyethanol.
Uses	Handicare Handwash has been formulated for professional use. The product is a liquid soap that does not contain medicaments or antiseptics. This ensures thorough cleansing of the hands, without leaving residues, in preparation for clinical procedures. The product does not contain fragrance (neutral odour), colouring or harsh preservatives to minimise the risk of irritancy. The lather formed on application and cleaning of the hands is rinseable under warm or cold water and is completely removed leaving hands noticeably (feeling) clean.

Clinical Procedure	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Wet skin and apply a small amount of Handicare Handwash. 2. Rub hands together thoroughly to spread handwash and form lather. 3. Follow an approved handwash protocol. 4. Rinse thoroughly. 5. Use disposable towel or air dry.
